

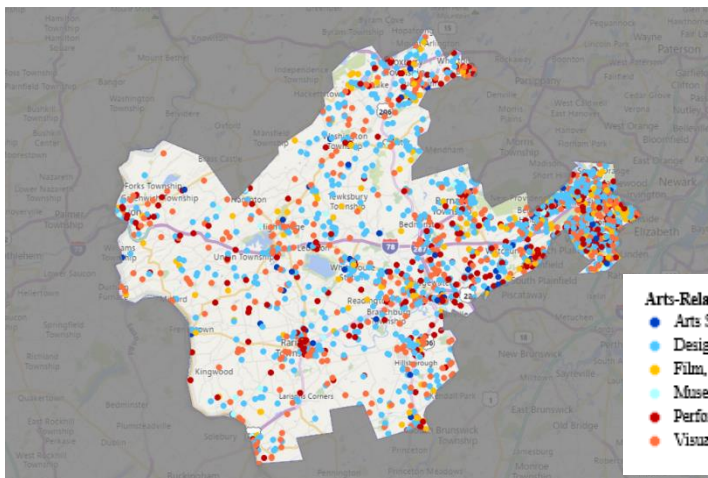


### Arts Facts... Creative Industries are Economic Engine

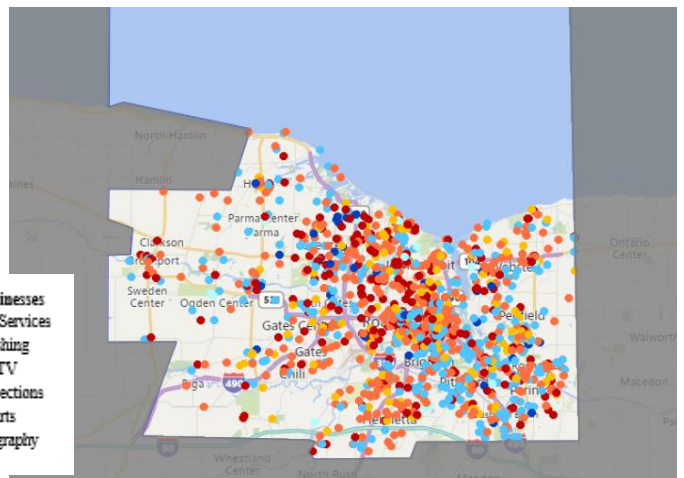
Nationally, 673,656 businesses are involved in the creation or distribution of the arts, and they employ 3.48 million people. This represents 4.01 percent of all U.S. businesses and 2.01 percent of all U.S. employees.

**The Creative Industries** study is a representation of the nonprofit and for-profit businesses involved in the creation or distribution of the arts. It is composed of arts-centric businesses that range from nonprofit museums, symphonies, and theaters to for-profit film, architecture, and design companies, based on 644 8-digit Standard Industrial Classification codes. The source for these data is Dun & Bradstreet, the most comprehensive and trusted source for business information in the United States.

**NJ-7 is home to 2,191 arts-related businesses that employ 8,162 people.** The creative industries account for 4.4 percent of the total number of businesses located in NJ-7 and 1.7 percent of the people they employ.

**NY-25 is home to 1,486 arts-related businesses that employ 9,993 people.** The creative industries account for 4.8 percent of the total number of businesses located in NY-25 and 2.3 percent of the people they employ.
